The Governing Board (GB) and Management of the National Centre for Hydrology and Meteorology (NCHM) would like to inform that as per recommendation of Organization Development (OD) carried out by the Royal Services Commission (RCSC), the Cabinet during its 92nd Lhyengye Zhungtsog (LZ) Meeting held on 11th December 2015 approved the proposal for establishment of National Centre for Hydrology and Meteorology (NCHM) by reorganizing of the Department of-met Services (DHMS) under the Ministry of Economic Affairs. The Centre was formally established in September 2016 and was delinked from the Ministry of Economic Affairs with effect from January 2017.

National Centre for Hydrology and Meteorology (NCHM) is an independent scientific and technical organization responsible for understanding the behaviours of atmosphere, its interaction with cryosphere and water bodies, the weather and climate and distribution of country's water resources. It is the nodal agency responsible for generation of information and delivery of products and services on weather, climate, cryosphere, hydrology and water resources in Bhutan.

The Centre is governed by the Governing Board (GB) and its members approved by the Cabinet from line agencies. The approved Centre logo is given below.
